DON'T COME ALONE—INVITE YOUR LEGISLATORS!

During the Legislative session, your legislators will vote on key issues with which they may not be familiar. This is your chance to make sure they are well informed about issues that are important to you.

It is as easy as 1, 2, 3...

1. Identify your legislators by calling the Voter Registration Office in your county or by going to the following

- website, **www.vote-smart.org**. (Be careful not to confuse your congresspersons with your state legislators.)
2. Contact your legislators by phone, mail or e-mail and invite them to the breakfast. Look up your legislators at **www.ganet.org** to get e-mail addresses and see photographs so you will recognize them at the breakfast.
 3. Be sure to thank your legislator for coming when you see him or her at the breakfast. Sit down with your legislator, share your ideas and enjoy breakfast together.

SECURITY

Due to the security procedures at the "Sloppy" Floyd Veterans Building, breakfast attendees will be required to enter the building through the main entrance located on Martin Luther King Jr. Drive. You will be required to show picture identification upon entering the building. Please allow a few extra minutes for this process. No one will be admitted through the crosswalk or via MARTA entrance without a State Identification badge. Your cooperation and understanding are greatly appreciated.

DIRECTIONS

IF TRAVELING SOUTHBOUND on I-85/I-75, take exit 248A (MLK/State Capitol/Stadium). Stay in the right lane off the exit ramp. The lane will yield to the right onto Butler Street. Park in the Butler Street parking deck which is the second (2nd) entrance on your right or, if full, the Grady parking lot is down the street on the right.

IF TRAVELING NORTHBOUND on I-85/I-75, take exit 246 (Central Avenue/Fulton Street). Follow the sign to Fulton Street and turn left onto Butler Street. Park in the Butler Street parking deck which is the second (2nd) entrance on your right or, if full, the Grady parking lot is down the street on the right.

If that lot has already filled there are other affordable lots available within five blocks of the Floyd building.

THE PARKING RATE is approximately \$8. ATTENDEES ARE ENCOURAGED TO TAKE MARTA.

The Georgia State Station (E1) is located in the Floyd building.
