MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH DATA HUB

The Maternal and Child Health Data Hub is an innovative platform that collates, analyzes, and visualizes crucial data related to maternal and child health. By consolidating information from various sources, including healthcare providers, public health agencies, and research institutions, the data hub offers a holistic view of the current healthcare landscape. It will enable policymakers, healthcare professionals, and researchers to make well-informed decisions and take proactive measures to enhance the quality of care and services for Georgia's families.

The Maternal and Child Health Data Hub is now the new home to HMHBGA's advocacy tool, Project 236. Project 236 is an advocacy tool that can be used to understand the state of maternal and infant health in your legislative district! Outcomes include rates of preterm birth, low birthweight, infant mortality, and prenatal care inadequacy. Advocates are encouraged to use this tool to speak with their legislators about comprehensive policy change.

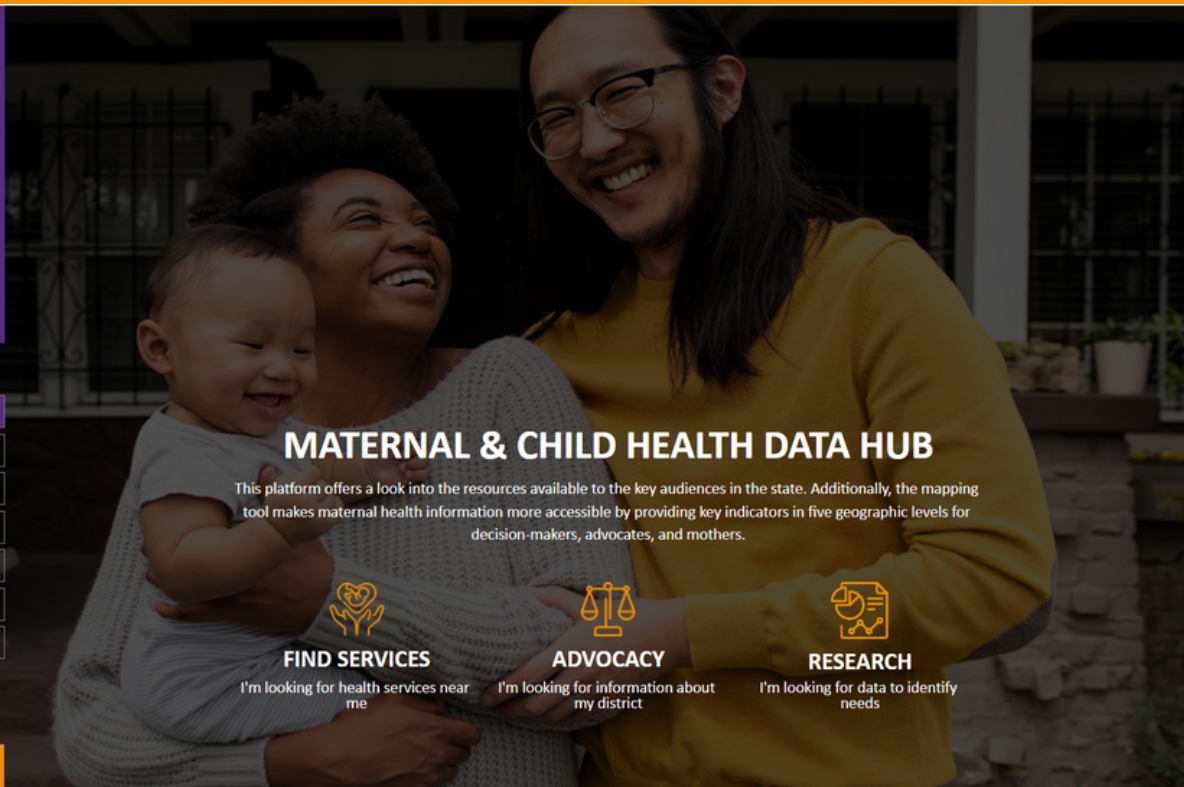
